We hope you are getting geared up for the most epic, unforgettable 10 days exploring the breathtaking, remote and rugged Top End of Australia!

We kick off from our Ellwood HQ in Cairns where we have sign on starting from around 7:20am. We have a 20% discount code with Rydges Esplanade.

We have a 7:10am pick up from Rydges, if you are on a BYO bike head over to 200 Hartley Street Bungalow by 7:30am.





This tour as you are aware is in remote areas of Australia so we carry satellite phones and EPIRBs for safety reasons and our lead and sweep riders are remote first aid qualified. Our tour itinerary is always subject to change throughout the 10 days due to weather, terrain, water crossings, breakdown, emergency situations, etc. We always have a backup plan in place if any problems arise and we are very experienced in dealing with all types of situations.

We have put together an amazing 10 days of riding across one of the continents last 'true frontiers' The Gulf of Carpentaria in the amazing Top End of Australia.

Day 1 starts our adventure out of the Ellwood HQ's in Cairns and heads straight out through the untouched Rainforests of the Far North Queensland and onto the rugged cattle country of the southern end of the Cape York Peninsula.

We have beautiful and varied destinations every afternoon where we finish the days ride and set up camp to enjoy the world go by from stunning beach camping on the Gulf of Carpentaria coastline to camping beside picturesque river systems on large cattle stations. We have hand-picked the best campsites available in the National Parks we visit to make it simple and easy to enjoy all that the parks have to offer literally from the door of your tent. If you would like a break from camping for a night along the way there are some options to upgrade and purchase some accommodation at some of our daily destinations. If this would be something that interests you please see further on for more details on how to book that.

We have some amazing and interesting stops every day to check out all sorts of hidden gems like historical sites of the early explorers, amazing waterfalls, 'lost city' rock formations, and an iconic Australian outback pub or two.

As we make our way west along the dusty outback tracks of the Gulf of Carpentaria it would be a sin to not make a detour into the remote North-West highlands to what is known as one of the most beautiful National parks in Australia, Boodjamulla (Lawn Hill) National Park to explore the rugged escarpments, sand stone ranges and heritage fossils. There is an option to head down the amazing gorges via canoe.



The afternoon can be spent relaxing in the water, canoeing the exquisite gorges or exploring the multiple walking trails which lead you through the sandstone cliffs lining the gorge.

Once hitting the Northern Territory border, we experience the interesting and varied scenery and track conditions of the Limmen N.P and tackle literally dozens of waterways and river crossings which makes for exciting riding.

We spend the night and explore a million acre outback property, large remote cattle stations and even try our luck and catching a Barra or two and spot a few crocs in the local rivers or relax by the thermal springs and visit a gorge or two.

We then head further North to stay the night at the remote Roper River, this is a great night of real adventure camping where we will be literally living off the bike. We will show everyone how to cook up super tasty meals with basic ingredients on our hiking style gas cookers.



After another day in the saddle is a welcome relief to stop in and have a soak at the natural thermal springs at Mataranka before heading West through the stunning Litchfield NP and what better way to do that than on your motorcycle, camping at Crab Claw Island on the second last night, we then have two options for the last day-an epic highly recommended tour through Matt Wrights Top End Safari Camp including a helicopter ride, Airboat tour, Monster croc feeding and Breakfast priced at \$495pp this tour is for 4 hours, if you prefer to have a more relaxed morning you can enjoy a breakfast and swim at Crab Claw Island and cruise down for a ride along Dundee Beach and wet a line. We will then regroup before finishing our adventure with an ice cold beer on the beautiful coastline of Darwin City with a farewell dinner and night out on the town with our newly formed life-long friends.

- We highly recommend canoe hire in Lawn Hill N.P and the Matt Wright Top End Safari Day Tour, These both are considered 'must do' activities whilst visiting the National Parks. Canoe hire is \$30 pp and Top End Safari Tour is \$495pp including helicopter flight, boat ride, meal and croc feeding.
- We stay at caravan parks, stations, camp grounds so there are showers and toilets available every night.
- We provide 3 cooked camp dinners and 2 cooked breakfast. The other nights
 you will be able to purchase dinner from the places we stay such as pubs and
 restaurants and breakfast can be purchased from cafes, road houses and

- supermarkets we stop to refuel at each morning. You can also stock up on snacks for the day from the fuel stops each day.
- For our riders bringing their own bikes on tour we recommend sorting out your bike freight as soon as possible to ensure there is no problems getting the bike to Cairns in time for the tour.
- If you require accommodation whilst in Cairns we have a great partnership and recommend Rydges Esplanade. They offer any of our customers a 20% discount on any accommodation. We will also have a link to their website attached in an email.
- We require full payment 4 weeks prior to tour departure, we will send out a reminder and another email with some further details about the tour.



For our guests bringing along their own bike we can also offer tips on setting your bike up for the tour if you are unsure on what would best suit your needs. See the attached checklist on what to pack and there is recommendations on camping gear and equipment. There is also information on what we recommend you take to ensure you don't overpack which can be very easy to do, not everything on the list is a must and if you are unsure on what to back please give us a call and we can talk you through it.

Here are some options for upgrading to accommodation along the way to break the camping up if your body needs a break here and there and calls for some aircon and a bed than please feel free to upgrade to any of these options, if you can get around to checking these out and booking as soon as you can so you don't miss out.

Night 10.- final night Hidden Valley RV Park (08)89842888 We have camping booked and paid for here at Hidden Valley Caravan Park, however this is one that we find most people upgrade to on our final night, there are Cabins available and if this is one you would like to upgrade to please give the guys at Hidden Valley a call and book. Our farewell dinner is right in Darwin Harbor so it can be easier for people to stay right in Darwin. Check out booking.com for places available. We provide a taxi service from Hidden Valley into Darwin city for the dinner.

Please note that camping destinations each could possibly change due to weather, rivers, injuries/accidents etc so please be aware of the cancellation policy at each place if booking accommodation.

There may be a chance to upgrade depending on availability when we arrive to the destination if you feel like a room along the way.

It is a good idea to carry some cash as well as your bank cards as EFTPOS is not always available. We recommend that you carry a few coins for washing machines along the way.





What we supply for Hire Bike option

For our riders hiring bikes from us, all are DRZ400s will come equipped with:

- Tent
- Air bed & 12V pump
- 12V outlet on your bike for charging
- Fold up camp chair
- Tarp
- Panniers Can hold up to 15 litres per side
- Duffle Bag for camping gear, for sleeping bag, pillow, sheet etc





What you will need to bring:

- Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Fitted king single or double bed sheet to fit over the bed.
- Towel and toiletries

Riding Gear & Clothing

- Helmet (Adventure helmet recommended)
- Boots (Motocross or adventure boots recommended avoid wearing old boots, they just fall apart and cause injury!)
- Riding socks
- Gloves
- Protective gear (Knee, Chest, Back, Elbow recommended)
- Jacket or Jersey
- Wet weather jacket
- Hydration pack (3 litres and enough room to carry snacks)
- Casual clothes Pants, shorts, shirts, jumper, thongs and shoes

You will be required to carry everything you are taking on tour in your luggage bags supplied on the bike.

There are two empty soft panners and a duffle bag on your bike to pack your gear in, these bags can easily fit all of your bedding, personal items and clothes in and has quite a bit of room. If you are unsure if what you want to bring along may not fit, let us know and we can assist you further.





PACKING LIST

- Helmet
- Boots
- Riding gear (long sleeve jersey and long pants)
- Riding socks
- Gloves
- Goggles
- Protective gear (recommended) Armour/Knee braces/pads/Elbow guards
- Light wet weather jacket
- 3 litre hydration backpack (3 litre is a must!)
- Pair of pants/jeans
- Shorts and shirts
- Jumper/flanno
- Thongs
- Toiletries
- Sleeping bag and pillow (we supply all camping gear apart from a sleeping bag and pillow)
- King single bed sheet in to cover your mattress
- Towel
- Sunscreen
- Camera
- Chargers/battery pack (there is 12V every day to charge from)
- Ear Plugs
- · Any special foods or snacks you would like to bring along
- Head Torch

When you arrive on the first day and unpack your personal items into the luggage bags provided, you can then place your other bags into the support vehicle. There is limited room so we ask that you please limit the size of bag to be placed in the support vehicle. Those bags will be accessible throughout the tour and will be there for you to collect in Darwin on the last day to then unload your hire bike items into your own bags.

The farewell dinner will be in Darwin City on the day 10 so you can then book flights for the following day home.

Itinerary is subject to change due to weather conditions, road closures or any other unforeseen circumstances.
